

State Affiliate Award

Deadline for Nominations: July 12, 2010

The ACNP State Affiliate Award is presented to a State Affiliate of the College in recognition of outstanding achievement. The award will be presented annually to a State Affiliate that has made a significant contribution to legislation, policy or regulation which promotes nurse practitioner practice.

Criteria for Nomination:

1. Must be a current State Affiliate member of the American College of Nurse Practitioners.
2. The accomplishment must be consistent with the ACNP mission and strategic plan.
3. A representative of the State Affiliate organization must submit an essay (1000 words or less) to the Awards Committee which includes documentation of each of the following:
 - a. Demonstration of a significant accomplishment in legislation, policy or regulation.
 - b. Include a summary description of the underlying problem, the actions or activities initiated and how the State Affiliate organization influenced the outcome of the initiative.
 - c. Present evidence that the State Affiliate was integral to the outcome of this accomplishment.
4. Provide two (2) letters of support from individual nurse practitioners involved in this activity. These letters should provide an explanation of the impact of this change on nurse practitioners in the state.
